



2008/2009 SCRIP
YEAR END REPORT
March 1, 2008 to February 28, 2009

SALES TOTALED \$991,295 with a profit of \$49,565 to the parish.

816 families out of a total of 4,000 families participate in this parish fund raiser.

136 school families shared \$16,740 in tuition rebates with one family receiving \$946 towards their 2009/2010 school year tuition.

35 PREP families shared \$1730 in tuition rebates with one family receiving \$247 towards their 2009/2010 PREP tuition.

15 St. Pius X families shared \$2222 in tuition rebates with one family receiving \$695 towards their 2009/2010 school year tuition.

24 families shared \$2679 in tuition rebates for other religious education schools with one family earning \$451 towards their 2009/2010 school year tuition.

Several families buy scrip and give their tuition credit to the "Needy Child" fund. \$835 was contributed to this fund.

As far as our shopping trends, the grocery stores were by far the most purchased with Giant (\$278,230) coming out on top. WAWA (\$64,325), Lowe's (\$26,475), Kohl's (\$74,275), Home Depot (\$16,625) and CVS (\$19,700) were the top highest retail stores. Purchase of Stores and More certificates of \$25,355 shows that the local stores participating in the program are among the favorites with our families.

A huge thank you to the families who participate in, and support this Parish fund raiser. This program returns on average 5% on the dollar.
